### MEDICATION POLICY

#### **Medication for students.**

Due to the nature of Foundation Futures programmes we will not administer medication to students during our sessions. If a young person requires medication it must be administered by parents, carers or approved school staff before the start of our sessions or after. If this is not possible the school must provide a member of staff to support those students throughout the Foundation Futures programme sessions.

As with all programmes full disclosure of medications, medical conditions and any other pertinent information for each young person must be provided by the partner school prior to that young person starting the programme. Any additional information deemed pertinent which affects their well-being or safety must be included on an Individual Risk Assessment (for example an allergy).

In the event of a young person being taken seriously ill during a session they will be taken to a local hospital or a 999 call will be placed with the ambulance service. Parents and carers will be contacted and the parent school informed. A Critical Incident form would then be completed and shared with partner school, parents and medical staff.
